Reflect & Interview:

Take a moment and think about how technology is used in your daily life. Think about some of the new technologies that are out in society (or coming out) and how it has/did/will change your life.

Now, talk (chat, skype, facetime, etc.) with a grandparent, aunt, uncle, or parent about what was one of the “newest” technologies when they were your age.

- ❖ Get details about this technology—what was it, when did it come out etc.
- ❖ Find out how it changed their life and/or society from their point of view.
- ❖ Find out why it was great from their point of view.
- ❖ Research to find out more about the technology they told you about and describe the technology from a “researchers” point of view.
 - REMEMBER do not cut and paste—paraphrase the information!!!

Directions:

Type a paper about who you talked with, what they told you about their “new technology”, and what you found out about this “new technology” from your research. Your paper should be well written, contain no spelling or grammar errors and be at least THREE (3) paragraphs in length.

You will type your **THREE (3)-paragraph** response (see above) in your LEP APPS account using the DOCUMENT(s) feature.

→ One paragraph = 4 to 5 sentences; One sentence = 6 to 8 words ←

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Create Your Document:

1. Re-name your document "Last Name Blizzard Bag 2"
2. Right Justify your First & Last Name
3. Return ONE time
4. Right Justify your class period
5. Return ONE time
6. Center, Bold & Italicize the Sentence Starter Statement in the HEADING
7. Return two times
8. First & Last Name
9. Left Justify & TYPE your response to the Sentence Starter Statement
 - a. Make sure you indent your first sentence of each paragraph
 - b. Make sure you capitalize the beginning of sentences
 - c. Make sure you have end of sentence punctuation
 - d. Make sure you do a spell check
 - e. Make sure your document saves properly
